All exhibitors must register at the arena to receive their exhibitor numbers
and bring their entries on **THURSDAY SEPT. 5th - BETWEEN 6 P. M. & 9 P.M.**
REGISTRATION IS FREE. All exhibitors must be off the floor by **9 P.M. SHARP**
All exhibitors must have their NAME, ADDRESS, EXHIBITOR #, SECTION, & CLASS
identified on their exhibit tags. **ONLY ONE ENTRY per CLASS per EXHIBITOR**

*No mark, initial or name will be visible until the prizes are awarded.

*All vegetable, fruit and flower entries must be grown by the exhibitor.

* All entries must be the work of the person entering it.

*The judges decisions will be final and no protests will be accepted. In the absence of competition in any section
or if the entry be of inferior quality, judges entry must award the entry only such prizes as they deem worthy of.

ALL THE ENTRIES MUST BE PICKED UP BY EXHIBITOR ON SUNDAY BETWEEN 3P.M. AND 4P.M. NOT BEFORE

HINTS

Pumpkins, Squash- leave stem attached,

Peppers, leave half inch stem,

Onions, do not peel or wash, just remove outer skir, leave topsat 1 in. above bulb.

Carrots, leave 1/2 in. top , tap root left on , wash lightly. Cucumber,leave 1/2in. Stem.

Beets, leave 1in. above crown roots trimmed back to no less than 1 in.

Cabbage, some outer leaves left on. Corn, 1/3 of husk removed from tip to butt. Potatoes, rinsed
